Designed to recreate the classic FDB furniture collection, the J-Series offers a functional design born out of industrial development.

FDB created a strong furniture concept in 1933, and under Børge Mogensen's leadership as design director from 1942, the FDB furniture linked industrial production closely with architectural furniture design. The primary focus was not on detailing, but on making well-designed furniture accessible to the general population. The industrial approach eliminated the need for special components and all chairs featured identical legs. FDB revolutionised the industry as a precursor of many of the design icons that Denmark is acknowledged for today around the world.

Folke Pålsson's Windsor-inspired J77 dining chair has a wide seat and curved spindle back for optimal comfort, while the slightly conical legs create extra stability. HAY's relaunched version is crafted in solid beech with a natural finish or a variety of coloured finishes.

CONSTRUCTION

Seat in moulded beech plywood with outer veneer. Legs are premounted with glue. Painted versions have a layer of paper on the top to prevent cracks to the veneer.

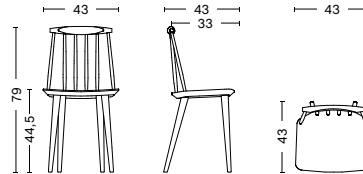
